Kings and Tulare County Farm Bureaus are offering a Cotton Harvest Safety Training Seminar from 8 am to noon on Wednesday, Sept. 26 at the Mid Valley Gin at 21978 Road 36, just south of Kansas Ave., in Tulare. Lunch is included and follows the training.

The seminar, conducted in both English and Spanish, will include information about first aid, equipment, fire and road safety, and heat stress. Safety materials are included and participants will receive a certificate of completion.
